Adult Academy (Jim Kaletka): There are 45 applicants to date, and the selection process should reduce the number to a more manageable 35 participants. (Thus far, our biggest class has been 34.) Selection process will be tomorrow night at 5:00 PM at APD headquarters. First academy is Wednesday, October 3rd at the APD Training Center. The course schedule will be emailed next week. Binder stuffing will take place next Thursday, September 27th at 5:00 PM at APD headquarters.

Mt. View Academy: This academy is for Mt. View residents only, and will be geared toward the culture of the area. It will be held January 10th - February 25th, in the evening. Some of the challenges will be car pooling, and getting community leaders to recommend applicants.
